The Kentucky Affiliate Award for Aspirations in Computing recognized ten high school women for their outstanding achievements and aspirations in computing and technology. Awardees were honored with a reception held in Rupp Arena on the University of Kentucky campus. The awards ceremony was part of Kentucky's eighth annual Student Technology Leadership Program (STLP) State Championship — an event that had nearly 5,000 students in attendance! During the event, Award Winners had the opportunity to explore STLP competition categories that covered a wide range of disciplines and combined content with technology, problem solving, and innovation. Members of the Kentucky Girls STEM Collaborative Project recognized the Aspirations Award recipients with trophies and prizes. Within the large group, the young awardees brought increased awareness of the Aspirations program while networking with fellow students, sponsors, community members, volunteers, and professionals from both industry and academia.
